The Board of Selectmen conducted a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment and opinion regarding the proposals submitted for inclusion under the 2012 Neighborhood Assistance Act Program (NAA).

The legal notice for said hearing has been published in the local newspaper and posted appropriately, and a copy of the application has been on file in the Town Clerk's office for public inspection.

Mr. Davidson read the program proposal submitted by the Regional YMCA of Western Connecticut at 2 Huckleberry Hill Road requesting Neighborhood Assistance Act funding in the amount of \$125,000 for the "This is Y" Community Support Campaign for the Neighborhood Assistance Act Credit Program, as published by the Department of Revenue Services.

The Neighborhood Assistance Act Program is a State program whereby those proposals judged to be eligible are able to receive donations from various persons or organizations. The program is designed to provide funding for municipal and tax exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses that make cash contributions to these entities. Persons making a donation are able to receive a tax credit. The Town is required by State law to hold a public hearing. There is no impact or expense to the Town of Brookfield.

There was no one present from the public to comment.

First Selectman William R. Davidson closed the Public Hearing at 11:05 a.m.
